### Why become a swim instructor:

- Possibility of part-time employment beginning in January 2024.
- Develops your qualities of leadership, professionalism, communication, teamwork, and your physical fitness.
- Allows you to gain experience in teaching, working with children, first aid and CPR - which can greatly benefit you in your future career plans.
- You may already have another job, but you have a few hours a week to help contribute to the success of the Campbellton Regional Community's swim lessons program.

### Description:

The Lifesaving Society Swim Instructor course prepares the instructor to teach and evaluate the swimming strokes and related skills found in the Lifesaving Society Swim for Life program. Candidates acquire proven teaching methods, planning skills, and a variety of stroke development drills and correction techniques.
